

Checklist for attending UAF Community and Technical College (CTC) as a Bachelor of Science Nursing (BSN) PRE-NURSING student

- Schedule an appointment with an Academic Advisor by calling 907-455-2800.
- Take Writing Placement Survey: <https://sites.google.com/alaska.edu/wrtg-placement/home> OR ACCUPLACER Test for English placement and bring test scores to advising appt, if you haven't taken ACT/SAT OR an English class within the past year. The Accuplacer test can take up to 2 hrs.
- Take the ALEKS Math Placement test prior to registering for a math class.
- Apply for a Certificate of Pre-Nursing Qualifications at UAF to work on prerequisites.
- Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), if you need financial aid.
- Complete non-nursing prerequisite courses at UAF/CTC, another UA campus, or a college outside Alaska. The courses listed on page 2 are based on UAF course numbers and equivalents.
- Complete 18 credits of General Education Requirements (GER) from UAF, UAA, or UAS, required for the UAA BS degree requirement. These can be taken in any order while working on the prerequisites and during the nursing program. However, two courses must be taken from the Humanities GER list (including the reasoning skills course), one from the Arts GER list, two from the Social Science GER list (one of which can be PSY F101 since it is required for PSY F240) and the STAT F200 course. *For the Alaska Native-themed GER, some courses can be counted towards both this requirement and one of the other GER courses.* Check with an advisor to account for all the needed GERs and double-counting.
- Maintain a minimum extracted GPA of 3.0 in BSN pre req courses and minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 in all courses. (The higher the better) A separate GPA will be calculated for the science courses: BIOL F111X and BIOL F112X. If completed, BIOL F240 will be included in the extracted GPA, but not in the Science GPA.
- Even though a clinical course such as HLTH F107- Nurse Aide Training, (9 credits) is not required for the BSN degree, most nurses and nursing students have found it useful to take.
- Take the TEAS VI Test (pre-nursing admission test) after extensive review. (Exams can be taken once every 6 months and the highest score is used for ranking). Contact eCampus Testing Services, 474-5277, at least a couple months ahead of desired test date to reserve a spot, then register with UAA testing. January and February test dates fill up fast so be proactive.
- Complete a UAA Undergraduate Application (\$50 fee) at least 3-6 months before the MAR 1st deadline to allow time for processing of transfer evaluations AND submit the School of Nursing (SON) Application (free) in advance of the MAR 1 deadline. Final prerequisite courses completed spring semester will be evaluated as part of the application process.

UAA Nursing Program in Fairbanks admits 16 students into the BS Nursing program each fall. It is a very competitive process. See [www. uaa.alaska.edu/nursing](http://www.uaa.alaska.edu/nursing) for more information.

These GER courses can be taken in any order.**
